A case study published in the US National Library of Medicine National Institute of Health states that letter tracing and handwriting has significant benefits over typing on electronic devices. The study tested the effect on brain engagement with traditional handwriting and typing on a tablet. The conclusion was that tracing and handwriting activates and engages both the left side of the brain which is responsible for language and logic and the motor cortex. Stimulation of these parts of the brain can provide benefits for the development of your child's brain and scholastic performance in the future.
